#### **4. Report Opportunities**

##### **Chair's Report**

VM informed the committee that the Moyleman race have offered a free place to Seaford Striders. It is conditional that whoever wins the place will raise money for a charity. VM will draft some conditions as to which members will be eligible to apply.

##### **Treasurer**

\*Current bank balance (both HSBC and Paypal) as of 03-July-2025 is **£6,044**. This is made up of £-115 of current year loss, plus £6,159 of retained earnings (cash in bank) rolled over from prior years.

There has been approximately £2000 in advance costs for the Mince Pie event.

With further expenses for the rest of the year it is anticipated that the account will break even with a £6000 profit.
